



## RULES FOR THE USE OF SCALLOW CAMPSITE

**Those hiring the Glamping Pods, please refer to the General Terms and Conditions. You do not need to be a member of the Camping and Caravanning Club to hire the Glamping Pods.**

### Arrivals

Members must report to the site owner before pitching and pay any site fees due unless these have already been paid or other arrangements have been made with the site owner.

Members must show their membership cards when requested to do so by the site owner.

Members must pitch where directed to by the site owner.

### Departure

Members should vacate their pitch on the day of departure at the time requested by the site owner.

Vacated pitches must be left clear of all property and refuse.

### Booking Policy

- Pitches can be booked for a maximum of 28 days. Please do not book a longer stay than this as we will need to amend or cancel your booking.
- Arrival times are after midday for camping. Arrivals for the Glamping Pods are after 2:00pm;
- Pitches must be vacated by 11:00am and left clear. Vacating the Glamping Pods must be by 10:30am.
- Dogs are permitted, but please keep them on a lead at all times and clean up after them and place bags in the bin. Dogs are not permitted in the glamping pods;
- All children must be closely supervised by an adult at all times;
- We are located in the countryside and operate a quiet site. There must be no amplified, loud or disrupting noise or music at any time and quiet time must be strictly adhered to between the hours of 10:00pm and 8:00am;
- We kindly ask you to take all your litter and waste with you, or disposing of it in the general waste and recycling bins.



## Camp Site & Glamping Pods

- We are unable to dispose of any broken camping equipment. Please take these home with you.
- No open fires or generators are allowed. BBQ's are permitted - please keep them off the ground to protect the earth beneath or place on the gravel hard standing. Fire Pits are provided for the Glamping Pods and materials are available at a cost of £10 per pod per night;
- Do not venture in to the wooded area, it's a protected area and strictly out of bounds.
- Vehicle speed 5mph
- If you are entering or leaving the site between the hours of 10pm and 8:00am, please make sure that you do not disturb the other campers on site.
- Scallows is not the place for large groups for stag or parties.
- Camping units are not permitted to be left unoccupied overnight on Scallow Campsite.
- The use of gas cylinders, with a capacity greater than 15kg, is not recommended on Scallow Campsite for supplying touring caravans, motorhomes or tents.
- If the site owner, or a member of staff feels that a member's behaviour, or the behaviour of a member's children or pets, is causing a nuisance, the owner is permitted to ask a member to cease the behaviour or leave the site.

### **Cancellation Policy**

- Cancellations made more than 14 days before the holiday start date will be subject to 50% cancellation fee, equal to your non-refundable deposit paid.
- Cancellations made within 14 days of the holiday start date will not be refunded.
- We suggest you take out the necessary holiday insurance to cover any losses.
